To All the Pupils,

On behalf of our charity, which manages and raises funds for Gena Heraty's work in Haiti, I wish to say a very sincere thank you for organising the "no unifom"day. The money raised on this day will make such a difference to Gena and all her team.

Gena's home is within the walls of an orphanage that is home to over 500 children. The orphanage is based high up in the mountains of Haiti. Haiti is naturally a very beautiful island in the Carribean but sadly it is a very dangerous and volatile country.

All the children attend the school within the orphanage that is run by NPH. There are several large two storey buildings within the walls of the orhphange that is home to the children. All the children would share a dormitory within each house with children of a similar age. No child would have the luxury of their own bedroom. All the meals are served at the same time and all the children in the house eat together.

The children in these orphanages would live a very different life to Irish children. For example, there are no washing machines in the orphanage. There is a team of ladies who wash all the sheets, children clothes by hand every single day. Can you imagine the amount of bed sheets that have to be washed? Children would not have the luxury of several different clothes, it really is the clothes they are wearing and a change of clothes when one set is in the wash.

Then in Gena's home there are 30 Special needs children & adults living with her. These children need 24/7 care so along with Gena, there is a team of local Haitian women helping her. The love and care that surrounds all the children in the orphanage is amazing and it really is one very large loving family.

Support such as yours is so important to Gena not just in practical terms but it gives her a real boost to know that she has such support from her home county. There are no words to describe what a remarkable lady Gena is, she is brave, caring and her whole life is devoted to those who cannot help themselves. Everyone in Mayo should be so proud of this remarkable woman.
